<sup>1</sup> Optional statewide for grades K – 2 math. Available grades K – 2 SLA. Math and ELA K-2 is required for RAMS schools. The first administration of Istation is recorded in the BOY, MOY, and EOY administration months. The BOY administration is in August, September, or October and is **optional**, not required for the 2020-2021. The MOY administration is in December or January. Each district should choose one calendar month for BOY and MOY administration. **SRCL/CLSD school districts will be required** to administer the Istation assessment in the 2020-2021 school year.

<sup>2</sup> Considered optional for LEAs, but highly encouraged to utilize as part of the Balanced Assessment System (BAS).

<sup>3</sup> Changes in the NAEP 2021 administration include a transition to a 3-block math and/or reading design. Information forthcoming.

<sup>4</sup> Avant Stamp must be administered to all students participating in a state-funded BMEP until proficiency is achieved. The assessment should be administered annually to measure Spanish language fluency growth for students.
